Walker Tote Pattern
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The **Walker Tote** organizer fits over most walkers and makes a stable holder for newspapers, game supplies, fiber arts and crafts, tissues and water bottles.

There are two roomy pockets on each side of the **Walker Tote** and Velcro holds the caddy securely.

MATERIAL LIST

- 1/2 yard 54 inch wide home decorator fabric
- 1 1/2 yards fusible fleece
- 1/3 yard Velcro
- 2 yards extra wide double fold tape (purchased or self made)

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Walker Tote

Cutting instructions

Cut fabric 14 X 54 inches.

Cut fusible fleece 14 X 54 inches.

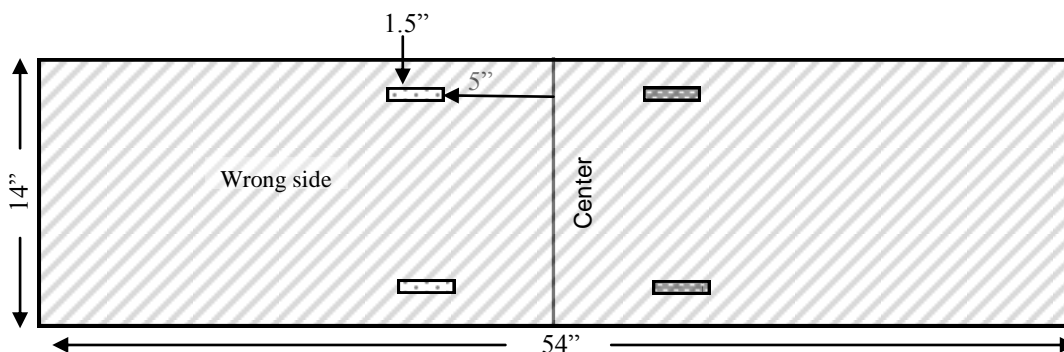
Cut four 3 inch pieces (2 sets) of Velcro.

Assembly

Fuse fleece to back of fabric. (May not be necessary for very heavy upholstery fabric.)

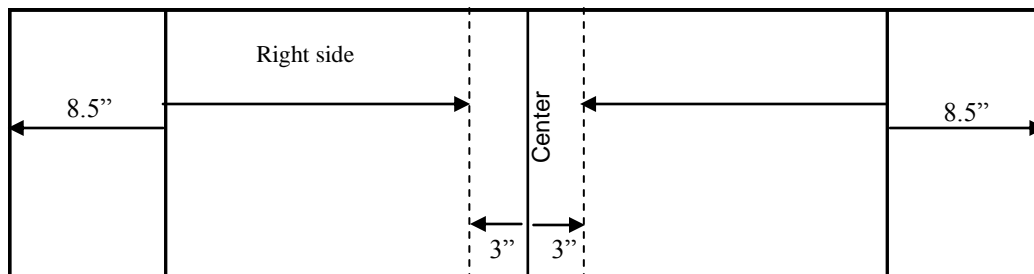
Velcro

On wrong side, sew Velcro 1 1/2 inches from the sides and 5 inches from the center fold.



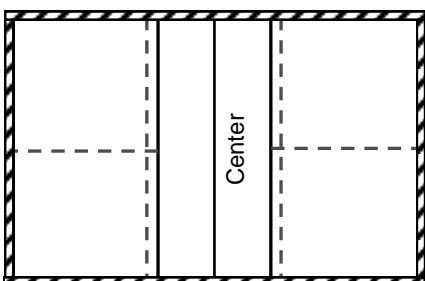
Pockets

On each side, fold on solid line and bring to broken line, forming pockets. Topstitch fold. Stitch down center of pockets, backstitching at top.



Binding

Apply binding to bottom edge, catching pocket bottom and fabric edge. (For upholstery fabric, bottom binding may be omitted.) Sew binding to each side. Finish each end by turning binding under before stitching.



Place over top bar of walker, matching Velcro.
